## 30 Hour Funding

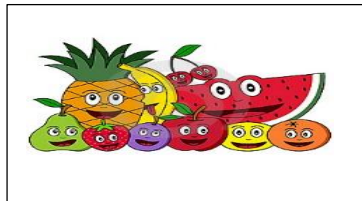
